Worldwide Biography Work embodiment and an international research group for research on the spiritual or esoteric fundamentals of biography work

A group of people had started in the 10th WBC in Hungary, a discussion about the incarnation of the worldwide biography work movement.

In this workshop we will ask following questions.

1. Is there a need for an organisation for the incarnation of the worldwide Biography Work movement?
2. If yes, how to create such an organisation which is structured but not hierarchical?
3. What would be the tasks for such an organisation? (Research, training, translation, archiving, collecting knowledge on different ways of using Biography Work, collecting learning about WBC, providing resources on how Biography Work can be applied/implemented; how can Biography Work be done professionally?)

World Social Initiative Forum

In this workshop we will explore the intentions promoted and practiced in the WSIF to shape individual and collective biography. Biography work can be an instrument in gaining understanding of the Self in relationship to itself, to others and to the world.

The WSIF is a network of individuals and organizations dedicated to sustainable social change. We promote individual and collective development by igniting authentic potential in service of the world. In the forums we co-create spaces of cross-cultural encounter and action research. We are currently running an online *Leadership in Transformation* program, progressing from personal through collaborative, to servant leadership. Our ethos seeks to demonstrate that self-mastery and virtuous practice can promote leadership in others.
